CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, St. Joseph's College of Education, Nirmala English Residential School, M.P.R. Dam, Garlandinne Mandal, Anantapur Dt-515731, Andhra Pradesh vide order No. F.AP/NEW/B.ED./79/SRO/NCTE/2003-2004/540 dated 24.12.2003 for conducting B.Ed. programme of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2003-2004.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulation 2014, the institution has submitted an affidavit to come under new Regulations vide dated 19.01.2015. Thereafter, the Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 30.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. AND WHEREAS, a Corrigendum was issued to the institution vide Order No. F.No.SRO/NCTE/APS09002/B.Ed./AP/2015/77343 on 31.10.2015 for reduction of intake from 2 to 1 unit.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st Nov 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents. A First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 20.11.2019. The institution vide letter dt. 14.12.2019 submitted a reply to First Show Cause Notice.

5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 394th meeting held on 27th - 28th January, 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. According, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 04.03.2021.

6. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 394th meeting held on 27th - 28th January, 2021 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. According, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 04.03.2021.

7. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 410th meeting held on 25th - 26th April, 2022 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, withdrawal order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS09002 /B.Ed./AP/2022 /131998-132002 dated 12.05.2022 was issued to the institution.

8. AND WHEREAS, the Institution filed a Writ Petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh against the Withdrawal Order dated 12.05.2024, where the High Court vide its order dated 01.04.2024 stated the following: -

"In the View of the above, the Writ Petition is allowed by setting aside the impugned minutes held on 25th and 26th April, 2022 and the matter is remanded back to the 3rd Respondent for fresh consideration, after conducting fresh enquiry by giving appropriate notice to the Petitioner. If at all, any deficiencies are found with the petitioner institute the respondents are at liberty to proceed in accordance with the provisions under Section 17 of the NCTE Act. No costs."

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted written representation vide letter received on 13.02.2024. The SRC in its 441st meeting held on 04th August, 2024 has considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 30.08.2024. The institution submitted its reply on 05.09.2024

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 458th Meeting held on 29th April, 2025 considered the reply submitted by the institution and decided as under: -

"The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

1. The SCN reply submitted by the institution on 05.09.2024 found to be satisfactory.

Hence, the Committee decided that the Continuation of Recognition order be issued to the Institution namely St. Joseph's College of Education, Nirmala English Residential School, M.P.R. Dam, Garlandinne Mandal, Anantapur Dt-515731, Andhra Pradesh for B.Ed. programme of 1 basic unit of 50 students."

11. **NOW THEREFORE**, as per the decision of SRC, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., St. Joseph's College of Education, Nirmala English Residential School, M.P.R. Dam, Garlandinne Mandal, Anantapur District- 515731, Andhra Pradesh for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme of (1 basic unit) of 50 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

12. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

13. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

14. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- e. Fee charged from students.
- f. Available infrastructural facilities.
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

15. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

16. The Institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

17. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
